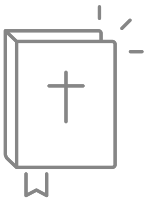


# JUSTICE & MERCY

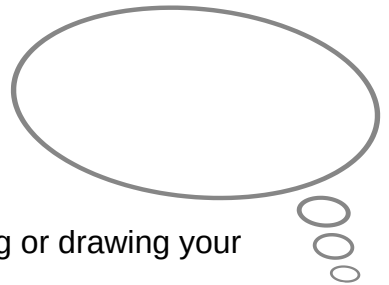
