

Tissue Paper Flowers



Step 1: Get 3 pieces of tissue paper. Stack the tissue paper and cut out a 6" square (the larger the square the bigger the flower; cut according to cross size).

Step 2: Fold the stacked sheets back and forth like an accordion, making 1" folds.



Step 3: Using scissors, trim the ends of the tissue paper strip to get a rounded or pointed edge.



Step 4: Loop the end of a pipe cleaner around the middle of the folded tissue paper.



Step 5: Starting on one side, begin opening the tissue paper folds.



Step 6: *Gently* separate the tissue paper sheets to unfold the petals of your flower. It will quickly begin to look like a beautiful blossom.

Step 7: Create more flowers and attach to the cross until it's covered in flowers.
